

Work Party Sunday 23rd October 2011

The October work party was held in pleasant conditions (mild, dry and relatively little wind). There were 9 volunteers who turned out on the day, including the two lads continuing their community service as part of their Duke of Edinburgh awards and a first-timer friend that came along with them. In addition, Rod, Phil and John had carried out some preliminary work on Thursday 20th October, moving logs from the west side to where they were needed for edging on the main path. The main work party accomplished further wood chip spreading, path edging (about 32 metres, plus stake preparation and driving them into the ground for a further 10 metres or so). We were also able to do some sycamore felling (about 25-30 small trees) to open up the under growth to help other species. We did not see many birds about today, only saw the odd robin and Jenny wren, even Jeremy the woodpecker didn't make an appearance.
