## **Summary:**

There were nests present in 12 of the 51 boxes, 10 of which were in the 27 older boxes and only 2 in the 24 newer boxes. This suggests that birds may prefer more weathered boxes or more familiar boxes, or simply that nests were sought before we installed the new ones in January 2012. Usage of these older boxes appeared to be significantly greater than in 2011. How many of these nests led to fledged youngsters it is impossible to tell, but one contained dead chicks and another contained unhatched eggs.
